MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING
OF THE
BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF
THE GREAT NECK LIBRARY ASSOCIATION, INC.

Tuesday, April 3, 1990

The public budget hearing of the Board of Trustees of the Great Neck Library Association, Inc., was held on Tuesday, April 3, 1990, at the offices of the Library on Bayview Avenue at Grist Mill Lane, Great Neck, N.Y. 11024

The President, Elayne Bernstein, called the public meeting to order at 8:05 p.m.

Arthur Lerner, Treasurer, reviewed the proposed 1991 Budget including the following categories, noting the increases:

Income

Increases in planned receipts are as follows:

Fines & Lost Books	\$ 2,000
Interest	15,000

Expenditures

Salaries	\$146,920 increase
Furniture & Equipment	10,000 decrease
Library Materials	47,954 increase
Operations	4,420 increase
Building Expenses	16,777 increase
Vehicle Transportation	200 increase
Employee Benefits	51,269 increase

Mr. Lerner stated that the proposed Great Neck Library Budget for 1991 is \$5,171,483, an increase of \$257,540. Estimated tax rate of \$1.88 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation, an increase of two cents.

Upon motion made by Dolly Relkin, seconded by Muriel Kane, and carried unanimously by the Board, it was,

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees adopt the proposed 1991 Budget in the amount of \$5,171,483, of which \$4,992,783 will be raised by taxation and that a letter and copy of the Budget be sent to the Great Neck School District.

LIBRARY BUS

Ken Weil, Library Director did not recommend expanding the regular bus route into June and September. Regular library bus service would stop at the end of May.

Motion made by Renee Zarin, seconded by Muriel Kane, and carried unanimously, it was,

RESOLVED, that the Library discontinue bus service for the month of June, and reconsider July, August and September.

Upon motion duly made and seconded, the public meeting adjourned at 8:25 p.m.
